

1-2 54 approx; S.H. dep - d.f.? (yes, looking back). N.H. continuous.
2-3. 54 " - but modern cutting spoils both m's & crown
M.H. still here. Then plantation over S. side & ditch.
-difficult to say.

4. Crooning positions before plantation end.

In plantation - V.D. so overgrown that it is impossible to say whether croonings
exist or not - seems to be 1 just before end of plantation, & S.H. dep.
Then modern cart-track to Codrington farm.

Ditch small but excellent: overgrown with gone; large M.H., S.H.
compensated with & difficult to tell where gaps are. N.H. not clear for gaps
- either.
All mounds very stoney.

Soon ditch seems to widen out - very like east of me, 23.

Mc. 25. Clear me. causeway - helped in modern times too by wide cutting thro' S.H.
Just west - M.H. large - very stoney - some clean material tho' in break
- some building stones with even. M.H. huge - yet ditch apparently
very narrow.

At crooning position - S.H. completely flattened for wide area - partially
modern I should say - slight d.f.? - difficult to say with certainty.
Break in M.H. here shows clean looking yellowish-buff material -
yet ditch not large & S.H. is high.

Next field: huge - S.H. huge & apparently continuous, N.H. ditto.

M.H. biggest yet - but ditch is really very narrow tho' deep, with
fairly steep sides.

S.H. shows slight dips of. Canfield's - - - - -

* Tho d.f.'s I don't think. (Impossible to look for spills outside mounds)

3rd. gap in S.H. just before N/S row of trees - modern crooning too.

Then V. splendid again, covered in gone. tho d.f.'s - steep-sided
ditch - huge M.H. - large N & S mounds.

Difficult to say wh. gaps in mounds are Roman.
Then road southwards.

Then wide rough field - meadow next showing 2 croonings - with
d.f.'s too. Then small paddock in front of houses on road.
- here M.H. clear.

Then V. croon beneath modern road.

Sat. May 31st. - beginning from Acorn Dell.

1st field:- gorge-covered with caravans.

- sample pace = 45

me. dk.:- Vallum not too bad - me. causeway & gap in S.M. fairly obvious. In this field, seem to be d.f.'s as well as regular gaps - reminiscent of Hatfield Piers.

me. causeway is no. 1.

2-3 50 paces.

3-4. 50 - d.f. clear.

Then quarrying away. Next field ploughed, this line of V.D. ditch ^{enough} next field - signs of crows or at least d.f.s in mounds.

Then gorge-covered patch before Greenfield.

Deps. in S.M. clear - ditch has quite flat-bottomed & seen with no signs of crows.

S. lip of V.D. not distinct - No H.M. I do not think.

S.M. quite good but hampered with.

Field after house:- N.M. nearly ploughed away. S.M. with field-wall on top. S.b. gloriously flat - Ditch quite small but quite deep. No H.M. - dep. in N.M. but difficult to decide when dep. in S.M. are Roman.

2/3 way up field - definite crows in ditch, & 2 rows Next field:- V. good - wall on S.M. spoils it rather.

Clear H.M. on S. lip + clear crows.

Start on one clearly added to in modern times.

1-2 : 52 paces - N.M. shows very faint dep. - can hardly tell in S.M. - large crows in ditch crows only halfway up ditch.

2-3 : 44 - S.M. dep. N.M. continuous.

Crows clear in ditch - H.M. still present.

3-4:- 49 - Spoils in modern times.

N.M. continuous - clear wide crows. S.M. dep.

+ H.M. as large as life.

Next field: same conditions recur - field-wall half-way between crows & no. 1. on the same side.
