Between 1866 and 1870, listed in publishers' advertisements as no. 6 of Routledge's new sixpenny toy books series

After 1868 became no. 46 of Routledge's new sixpenny toy books series, listed as such in publishers' advertisements between 1871 and 1882

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#### NOTES

Printed on one side of the sheet only; first and last page pasted to upper and lower wrappers Title and publication information from upper wrapper, which serves as title page, and from lower wrapper publishers' advertisements

Documents make no difference between this title as belonging to Aunt Mavor's toy books series or to Routledge's new sixpenny toy books series
