[1855]: upper wrapper uniform for the series (see [pcb2397](#), variant B), on greenish blue paper, with plain title: "[plain] CINDERELLA."; 1855 lower wrapper as [pcb2275](#), variant D, on greenish blue paper; at foot, inside the decorated frame: "LONDON: | GEORGE ROUTLEDGE & CO., FARRINGDON STREET. | NEW YORK: 18, BEEKMAN STREET."; note that Routledge's New York address was in use after May 1854 but the thirteen titles of Routledge's new series of sixpenny juvenile books were published in May 1855 (*Publishers' Circular* (May 15, 1855): 188)
